(1) Bernard Brown, under the special CETA program, part-time, approximately 10 hours per week, at the rate of \$4.00 per hour, during the period October 1, 1978 thru October 31, 1978, and to continue if the CETA program remains in existence.

(2) Gregory Hammel, part-time, approximately 10 to 12 hours per week, at the rate of \$160 per month, effective October 1, 1978.

Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board to recommend the approval of an application of Cities Service Gas Company for authority to construct a gas line across a Douglas County road at a point approximately 900 feet north of the center corner of Section 34, Township 12S, Range 19E in Douglas County, Kansas, and running across Monterey Street in Douglas County. It is proposed by the application to lay a 16-inch gas line across Douglas County road at the point specified in accordance with plans and specifications submitted with the application. After review and discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this authority to construct be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried.
