Dist att. i 2 Chicks to reimburse for Child Support Collection

The Board noted receipt of the following from the State of Kansas Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services: Two checks as reimbursements for the 15% incentive on the Title IV-D Incentive payment for child support collec-Title IV-Deficientive tions for the month of September, the amount of \$375.30, and Interstate Incentive in the amount of \$27.90 both of which shall be reimbursed to the general fund. Also received is a check in the amount of \$982.80 which is a 75% reimbursement for administrative expenses reimbursable under the Cooperative Agreement of the Title IV-D Program for the months of July, August, and September 1978. This amount is reimbursable directly to the District Attorney's budget.

Pub. Works: app amend Swallow Italiment

The Board reviewed the Statement of Basis for Offer on Project No. FAS 23-RS-1347(7) relating to Tract No. 4 which is owned by Vern Swallow and Esther Swallow. This amended statement is being altered slightly upward based upon additional amount offered for compensation for rebuilding a ditch crossing in pasture south of project. The original statement was in the amount of \$9,800 and the amended statement is for \$10,400. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this amended Statement of Basis for Offer be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

(4) That the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience by said vacation.

(5) That said order of vacation should reserve unto the petitioner and the owners of any lesser property rights for public service utilities, rights of-ways and easements for public service facilities now in existence and use.

(6) That the Governing Body of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, did on the 26th day of September 1978, unanimously approve and authorize the filing of this petition and all proceedings hereunder.
