16,300 19,000 Be it noted that all of these salaries reflect an approximate 7% increase with the exception of the Sheriff which is subject to a sizeable special adjustment based upon a substantial increase of responsibility which has been placed upon that position. Motion seconded by Mrs. Bradley and carried unanimously. It is the Board's intention that these salaries become effective with the pay period beginning December 23, 1978.

The Board reviewed potential merit increases for appointed department heads. After complete review, discussion, and evaluation of the performance of these various department heads, it was moved by Mr. Neis that the following merit increases be provided to be effective January 6, 1979:

Data Processing Coordinator, an increase of 2%, \$343, or an annual salary of \$18,163.

Zoning Administrator, an increase of 2%, \$271, or an annual salary of \$14,371.

Weed Department, an increase of 2%, \$201, or an annual salary of \$10, 629.

Emergency Preparedness Coordinator, an increase of 1%, \$144, or an annual salary of \$14,772.

Budget Director, an increase of 3%, \$461, or an annual salary of \$16, 433.
