Miller, clerk, from \$520 to \$556 (1 to 2 year bracket); and Eunice Smith, deputy, from \$763 to \$775 (5 to 10 year bracket). After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that Eunice Smith the recommendations be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.
