The agreement indicates that relocation of existing facilities which are currently located on private easement will be paid for by Douglas County and that those facilities within county right-of-way will be moved at utility company expense, and that the construction or alterations of the company's facilities shall be completed within thirty days after the county furnishes to the company the required information.

(2) Between The Kansas Power & Light Company and the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County for Bridge No. 10.90N-16.45E which agreement relates 10,90 kl-16,45 E to provisions of K.S.A. 17-1901 as to the necessity for movement of utility equipment and facilities which are located on county right-of-way. The agreement indicates that relocation of existing facilities which are currently 10cated on private easement will be paid for by Douglas County and that those facilities within county right-of-way will be moved at utility company expense, and that the construction or alterations of the company's facilities shall be completed within thirty days after the county furnishes to the company the required information.

(3) Between Southwestern Bell Telephone Company and the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County for Bridge No. 12.75N-19.27E which agreement relates to provisions of K.S.A. 17-1901 as to the necessity for movement of ut-1275 N-19.27E ility equipment and facilities which are located on county right-of-way. The agreement indicates that relocation of existing facilities which are currently located on private easement will be paid for by Douglas County and that those facilities within county right-of-way will be moved at utility company expense, and that the construction or alterations of the company's facilities shall be completed within sixty days after the county furnishes to the company the required information.
