The Board approved Commissioners Cancellation Order No. 1873. Order is on Comm. Order: file in the office of the County Clerk.

Mike Malone, District Attorney, appeared before the Board to recommend the em-Pessonnel : Employ ployment of E. Ann Boyle in the position of legal and child support secretary at the starting salary of \$617 per month, effective May 1, 1979. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

Le Calp<sup>6</sup>. Ted McFarlane, Douglas County Ambulance Service Manager, appeared before the Board to recommend wage adjustments for personnel in his department. Mr. Mcall ambulance Farlane stated that the Kansas Minimum Wage and Maximum Hour Law (K.S.A. 44-1201 et. seg.) was amended to include those "engaged in the delivery of emergency medical services" in the overtime exemption previously granted to only law enforcement and fire protection personnel. This change was effective April 26, 1979 when it was published in the Topeka Daily Capitol. Mr. McFarlane therefore requested that the Board approve the following wage adjustments, to be effective April 28, 1979, to take advantage of the new provisions:
