Fremont Hornberger, maintenance supervisor, appeared before the Board to recom mend the employment of Henry Pringle as grounds maintenance, full time, temporary, at the rate of \$3.15 per hour, effective May 21, 1979. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried.

Mr. Charles Stough, special bond counsel, appeared before the Board to review Vankee Tank#2! the financial obligations in connection with Yankee Tank Main Sewer District Mates issued to No. 2, Douglas County, Kansas, including engineering and legal fees to date, and anticipated costs of rights of way for the installation and construction of the trunk sewer. It appeared that approximately \$250,000 would be required to take care of present obligations and other demands within the next 30 to 60 days. It was suggested that the County issue \$250,000 in temporary notes, with five notes in denominations of \$50,000 each. Local banks had advised the County that they would purchase this issue of temporary notes at a rate of six percent (6%) interest, pending the issuance of bonds.

Ted McFarlane, Douglas County ambulance service manager, appeared before the ambulance: app Board to discuss the bids which were opened on April 26, 1979, for a speciaccept low bid fied ambulance vehicle and equipment. Four bids were received from suppliers lane recommended the acceptance of the bid from Emergency Equipment Supply

Corporation of Fort Smith, Arkansas, to supply a Yankee built Lexington, long wheel base vehicle, at the total amount of \$34,994, with a delivery period of 85-120 days.
