June 6, 1979 The Board of County "Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present. Approved the minutes of the meeting of June 4, 1979. The Board approved Commissioners cancellation Order No. 1881. Order is on omm. Onder file in the office of the County Clerk. Kathy Smith, Valleyview Administrator, appeared before the Board to recommend Rensonnel : Employ Honace Lang LynnHanold hiring for Valleyview as follows: (1) Horace K. Liang, to fill the position of orderly, temporary, parttime, at the rate of \$3.00 per hour, having begun work on June 4, 1979. (2) Lynn E. Hanold, to fill the position of nurse aide, temporary, full time, at the rate of \$2.90 per hour, having begun work on June 5, 1979. After discussion on these requests it was moved by Mr. Neis that they be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously. Term. Ms. Smith then notified the Board that Geraldine F. Iron Whiteman, employed Steraldinch hiteman under the CETA Title VI program, terminated on June 1 and Debra Hutchison terminated on June 1. Ms. Smith then recommended that Thomas Sievert be transferred from the posi-Lans. tion of orderly to the position of head housekeeping effective May 26, 1979. Themas Sievert Ms. Smith recommended that his rate of pay be increased from \$2.90 per hour to \$3.10 per hour. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this request Serie Com be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously. Ruth Foster F/T Keven Carley P/T Ms. Smith then notified the Board of the following changes in personnel at Reddie Aloues // Valleyview effective May 26, 1979: Gene Conn from full-time third cook to part-time office assistant, Ruth Foster from part-time to full-time, and Kevin Carter and Zeddie Glover from full-time to part-time. Employ Sheriff Rex Johnson appeared before the Board to recommend hiring as follows: fichard Julian (1) Richard D. Julian, to fill the position of correction officer, full Mychael Column time, temporary, at the rate of \$700 per month, having begun work on May 27, (1) Richard D. rector, State Board of Agriculture, appeared before the Board with four quotes for Roundup chemical. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that the Board accept the low quote of Robert S. Wise, Wichita, Kansas, for Roundup in the amount of \$50.24 per gallon, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

Fremont Hornberger, maintenance supervisor, appeared before the Board with two quotes for a push lawn mower and a self-propelled lawn mower. Mr. Hornberger recommended the Board accept the low quote of Deems Farm Equipment, Inc. in the amount of \$268 for the 21-inch self-propelled mower with bagger and \$198 for the 21-inch push mower with bagger, making a total cost of \$466. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet at 8:15 a.m., Thursday, June 7, 1979, to hold public hearings on revenue sharing requests.
