Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board and presented Resolution No. 79-24. The Board finds and determines upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the speed limit for the following described county road or highway, to-wit: Beginning approximately 1200 ft. West of the South Quarter Corner of Section 27, Township 12 South, Range 18 East, in Douglas County, Kansas, said point being on the center line of Federal Aid Secondary Route 212; thence East on said center line to said Quarter Corner, as set by K.S.A. 8-1560, is greater than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist on the above described county road or highway under the jurisdiction of this Board. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that the Board adopt Resolution No. 79-24 establishing a speed limit of 40 miles per hour on the above described county road or highway, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously. This speed zone shall be automatically rescinded at such time as County Road 442 is again opened to thru traffic from the Southwest Corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 27, Township 12 South, Range 18 East to the Southwest Corner of Section 25, Township 12 South, Range 18 East, Douglas County, Kansas.

Mr. Dooley then presented Resolution No. 79-25. The Board finds and determines upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the speed limit for the following described county road or highway, to-wit: Beginning at the South Quarter Corner of Section 27, Township 12 South, Range 18 East, in Douglas County, Kansas, said corner being the junction of F.A.S. Route 212 and F.A.S. Route 1273; thence North approximately one and one-half (1½) mile to the junction of Federal Aid Secondary Route 1273 and U.S. Highway 40, as set by K.S.A. 8-1560, is greater than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist on the above described county road or highway under the jurisdiction of this Board. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that the Board adopt Resolution No. 79-25 establishing a speed limit of 30 miles per hour on the above described county road or highway, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously. This speed zone shall be automatically rescinded at such time as County Road 442 is again opened to thru traffic from the Southwest Corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 27, Township 12 South, Range 18 East to the Southwest Corner of Section 25, Township 12 South, Range 18 East, Douglas County, Kansas.
