The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with two members of the Board present. Mr., Cragan was absent.

Approved the minutes of the meeting of August 30, 1979.

Versennel: Employ Fremont Hornberger, maintenance supervisor, appeared before the Board to recommend hiring as follows: Robert Kutilek Charles Bray

(1) Robert J. Kutilek, to fill the position of custodian, at the rate of \$550 per month, to commence work on September 6, 1979.

(2) Charles L. Bray, to fill the position of grounds maintenance, at the rate of \$550 per month, to commence work on September 17, 1979.

After discussion on these requests it was moved by Mr. Neis that they be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried.

Ted McFarlane, Douglas County Ambulance Service Manager, appeared before the Board to request that the Board approve the following personnel changes:

Works: app. Tom McGee, engineering division manager, appeared before the Board to present Contracto R/W a contract for right-of-way for Project No. F.A.S. 23-R.S.-1528(2), between the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County and Nora Skaggs and Richard W. 1745 23 R.S-1528(2) Skaggs, husband and wife; William C. Garner and Sharon C. Garner, husband and wife; and Betty L. Wasson and Donald Wasson, husband and wife, for purchase of 3.90 acres of right-of-way easement and 0.26 acres of temporary easement for construction, in the lump sum of \$6,000. This lump sum payment also includes allowance for abstracting (2.tracts), irregularity of boundary, severance of existing tract, and 0.5 acres of brome. After review of this contract it was moved by Mr. Neis that it be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried.
