Class I Excavation, Class II Excavation, Class AAA Concrete, Steel Piles, Steel Piles (Cut Off), and Concrete Ditch Lining a net decrease of \$3,110.30 for a final contract price for this bridge in the amount of \$137,034.90.

## Bridge No. 16.30N-02.00E

Class I Excavation, Class II Excavation, Steel Piles, Steel Piles (Cut Off) and Steel Piles (Splice) a net decrease of \$516.60 for a final contract price for this bridge in the amount of \$71,371.50.
