Net increase of \$478 for a final contract price for this Bridge is in the amount of \$71,849.50.

It is noted by the Board that this recommendation is concurred in by the contractor, Midwest Construction Company, Inc.; by Finney & Turnipseed representative John W. Frazier; by the bonding company represented by John M. Koger, attorney-in-fact, and Mr. Dooley. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this change order be approved as recommended, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried.

Revised agreement  
on 14.55N-21.70E*

Mr. Dooley then presented the Board three copies of a Revised Agreement covering Engineering services on field surveys, designs, plans, and specifications for the proposed rehabilitation of Bridge No. 14.55N-21.70E over the Wakarusa River. The original Agreement transmitted by Finney & Turnipseed, consulting engineers, had anticipated that the roadway would be widened to 30 feet which would have required the widening of the approach roadway on both ends. The revised Agreement is based on a 24 foot roadway with a barrier type curb and a HS-20 design live load. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this Revised Agreement be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on Thursday, December 20, 1979.
