At the advertised hour of 10:00 a.m., the Board received sealed bids to pro-vide and install energy conserving storm windows on most exterior window openings of the Douglas County Courthouse which is a National Historic Site. The two bids received were from Kennedy Glass, Inc., Lawrence, Kansas, and L. O. McCurry Co., Inc., Grain Valley, Missouri. After brief discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that these bids be taken under advisement and that Mr. Fremont Hornberger and Mr. Ernest Coleman review them to make a recommendation at a later time to the Board, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried

Mike Dooley, Public Works Director, presented the Board an application from Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, Topeka, Kansas, seeking authority to construct buried telephone cable beside and across a county highway at a point approximately 1,760 feet north of the southeast corner of Section 2, Township 14S, Range 18E, in Douglas County, Kansas, and running Southwest on County Road 462 through Douglas County, and leaving said County on County Road 462 and 1031 Junction approximately at center of Section 11, Township 14S, Range 18E, in Douglas County, Kansas. The application is to bury twenty five pair of telephone cable. This application has been thoroughly reviewed by the Public Works Department and its approval is recommended to the Board by Mr. Dooley. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that it be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried.

Plan. Depl. app. Mrs. Bradley and Mr. Cragan discussed the planning item from the Joint Planning Commission meeting, Lecompton Planning Commission and Lawrence-Douglas CUP decemptor County Planning Commission, minutes of January 16, 1980. This item is CUP-12-6-79 which is a request for a Conditional Use Permit to allow the City of Lecompton to construct a water supply well on the property generally described as being located approximately 1/4 mile northwest of the city limits. Mrs. Bradley deferred this matter on Monday, February 4, 1980, until such time that the County Commission had a regular Board meeting. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this Conditional Use Permit be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried.

> Douglas County Bond Attorney Charles Stough appeared before the Board to discuss a resolution authorizing the public sale of \$500,000 General Obligation Parkway Bonds, Series 1980, of Douglas County, Kansas. After full discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this resolution authorizing the public sale of \$500,000 General Obligation Parkway Bonds be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried.
