Mr. Little then presented the Board the Computer Service Agency (CSA) Budget for Fiscal Year 1981 in the amount of \$142,118.77. It is indicated that the first installment is due on or before July 1, 1980 in the amount of \$71,059.39 and the second installment is due by January 15, 1981 in the amount of \$71,059.38. After review it was moved by Mr. Neis that this 1981 Budget for CSA be approved as follows: \$57,118.77 from the data processing line item for computer services and \$85,000 from revenue sharing funds. Motion seconded by Mr. Cragan and carried unanimously.
