l'Terre Fremont Hornberger, maintenance supervisor, notified the Board that Steven Bennett will terminate on May 30, 1980.

> Sheriff Rex Johnson appeared before the Board to recommend the employment of Kenneth M. McGovern, in the position of part-time corrections officer, at the rate of \$759 per month, effective May 19, 1980. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

George Little, data processing director, appeared before the Board to recommend a six-month merit increase for Julie Coons in the amount of \$31 per month, bringing her salary from \$719 per month to \$750 per month, effective July 5, 1980. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously. It should be noted that this is an exception to our policy because of action taken by Mike Ater while he was acting data processing director.

Mr. Little then presented the Board the Computer Service Agency (CSA) Budget for Fiscal Year 1981 in the amount of \$142,118.77. It is indicated that the first installment is due on or before July 1, 1980 in the amount of \$71,059.39 and the second installment is due by January 15, 1981 in the amount of \$71, 059.38. After review it was moved by Mr. Neis that this 1981 Budget for CSA be approved as follows: \$57,118.77 from the data processing line item for computer services and \$85,000 from revenue sharing funds. Motion seconded by Mr. Cragan and carried unanimously.
