Dan Young, county counselor, presented the Board Charter Resolution No. 80-7-2 which is a charter resolution exempting the County of Douglas, State of Comm. may levy taxes for County expenses. Kansas, from K.S.A. 1979 Supp. 79-1946, providing substitute and additional provisions on the same subject; and authorizing the levying of taxes for the current general expenses of the County and for payments of a portion of principal and interest on bonds issued under the authority of K.S.A. 1979 Supp. 12-1774 and amendments thereto. By this charter resolution the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, is hereby authorized to fix a rate of levy annually to meet and defray the current general expenses of the County and to pay a portion of the principal and interest on bonds issued under the authority of K.S.A. 1979 Supp. 12-1774, and amendments thereto, by any city located in Douglas County, subject to the limitation that the maximum levy for such purposes shall not exceed a levy of .570 mills upon each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation, and provided that said maximum levy shall be reduced by an amount equal to or in excess of the State of Kansas distribution made pursuant to K.S.A. 1979 Supp. 79-2959, K.S.A. 79-2960, and K.S.A. 79-2961, and Douglas County shall comply with the provision of said statutes. This charter resolution shall be effective upon its publication in the official County newspaper. After complete review it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this charter resolution be adopted, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously. The Board met with Darlene Hill, budget director, and various department heads relative to lowering the preliminary 1981 Douglas County Budget.
