The Board of Douglas County Commissioners met in special session on August 26, 1980, with all members of the Board present.

Mass Bridge;
Deny as base
of operation for
work on Dam

The purpose of the special meeting being to act on the Agreement which Bowersock Mills and Power Company desires to obtain the authority of the County to use the East one-half of the Massachusetts Street Bridge roadway as a base of operation for the use of a truck and winch as an alternate means of raising the flash boards located on the Bowersock Dam. This Agreement was presented to the Board on Monday, August 25, 1980.

Inasmuch as the City of Lawrence has certain time limitations with respect to the old mill building and the Board of County Commissioners does not wish to delay its decision to the last minute regarding the application of the Bowersock Mills and Power Company to use the Massachusetts Street Bridge and inasmuch as the Board has discussed said application and proposed Agreement and the consensus appears to be that it is in the best interest of the public that uninterrupted flow of vehicles and pedestrian traffic be maintained across the Kaw River Bridges to the maximum degree possible, it was moved by Mr. Neis that the Board of County Commissioners decline to approve the proposed Agreement for the reason that it would prevent maximum use of the bridge for vehicular and pedestrian traffic, and upon passage of this motion the Board should notify the City of Lawrence of this decision with our expression of regret for any inconvenience this decision may cause the City and our appreciation for the time the City officials have expended in making us aware of the issues involved in this matter. Motion seconded by Mr. Cragan and carried unanimously.
