Mr. Dooley then presented the Board Contract for Federal Aid Road Construction by County for Project No. 23 C-1374-01 (HES-000S (062)), whereas, the Secretary of Transportation of the State of Kansas, as Agent for Douglas County, Kansas, authorizes said County to perform certain construction work on the above noted Project No. consisting of Signing - Various Locations in Douglas County. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this contract be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Dooley then presented an Agreement between The Kansas Power & Light Company and Douglas County for Project 23C-1166-01 (Formerly 23-SOS-450(1). Douglas County intends to improve a portion of Douglas County Road No. 138 and replace Bridge No. 11.95N-20.70E, described as follows: Beginning at a point 657.91 feet East of the N.W. corner of the Northeast Quarter (N.E.14) thence East 1000 feet and terminating at said point. The cost of the alterations, if any, shall be paid for by The Kansas Power & Light Company. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this Agreement be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Dooley then recommended the acceptance of a Supplemental Agreement, Change Order No. 1, for Douglas County Bridge and Grading Contract for Consolidated Project No. 79-2 as follows:

Net increase of \$494.38 for a final contract price for this bridge in the amount of \$123,164.68.
