Res. 81-9; app. Wayne Kellum, zoning administrator, presented the Board Resolution No. 81-9. By this resolution it is unanimously resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County that under the "Zoning Regulations for the Unincorporated Territory of Douglas County, Kansas," Article 19, Section 19-4 be amended to add the following Conditional Use:

25. Farm implement repair service. Sales shall be restricted to repair service and replacement parts. Open storage must meet the minimum yard requirements of the district in which it is located and must be screened from adjacent public roads and adjoining properties by a view-reducing wall, fence, or landscaping material.

After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this resolution be approved and published in accordance with the requirements of the law, seconded by Mrs. Bradley. and carried unanimously. Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Kellum then presented the Board Resolution No. 81-10.
