Mr. Dooley then presented a quote for 3800 tons of road rock, Kansas Standard Specifications for Road & Bridge Construction Edition 1980, CM-H, in the amount of \$5.10 per ton for a total of \$19,380 from Killough, Inc., Ottawa, Kansas. The bridge will be Water Resources a 66'-82'66' continuous steel beam bridge, pile bent abutments, pedestal piers on steel pile, 28'-0" reinforced concrete roadway across the Wakarusa 5-13-19 River located near the center corner of Section 5, Township 13S, Range 19E, on a north-south township road in Douglas County, Kansas, carrying traffic over the Wakarusa River at a location where the existing bridge will be removed.
