The Board considered a document titled Authority to Award Contract Commitment of County Funds on Project No. 23 C 1245-01 (Formerly BRS 509 (11)), which document indicates that a low bid received on the above project was from Taylor Construction Company, Inc., Lenexa, Kansas, in the amount of \$205,846.50 for bridge repair Br. Sta. 19+04, and that county funds on this project is \$45,287 which funds are hereby pledged to be remitted to the State of Kansas on or before June 1, 1981. By this document the Board resolves that we find the bid described above to be acceptable and that the Secretary of Transportation is hereby authorized to award the necessary contracts for the completion of the work on this project as was bid. After review it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this Authority to Award Contract Commitment of County Funds be executed and forwarded to the Secretary of Transportation, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.
