YankeeTank Hearing objections Hearing objections At 11:00 a.m. the Board sitting as the governing body of Yankee Tank Main Sewer District No. 2 met pursuant to published and mailed notices to all property owners in the district for the purpose of hearing objections to assessments made on all parcels of land as set out in Resolution No. 81-22. After a number of landowners expressed their objection, the Board determined that no valid objection had been made as to the legality of the assessments.
