The Board noted receipt of Permit from the Kansas State Board of Agriculture, Division of Water Resources, relating to the construction of a reinforced concrete slab bridge (spans 37' - 50' - 37') and channel change along the Haskell drainage ditch at a location in the NE¹/₄ of Section 18 and the NW¹/₄ of Section 17, Township 13 South, Range 20 East, Douglas County, Kansas. This is for Bridge No. 11.95N-20.70E. The approved Permit has been remitted to the public works department for their file.

Ted McFarlane, Douglas County ambulance service manager, appeared before the Board to give an update report on the proposed ambulance station at the Lawrence Memorial Hospital. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that the Board retain the services of Walter J. Hicks Associates, Lawrence, as the architect for renovation of the ambulance station located at 1839 Massachusetts and also for the proposed ambulance station at the hospital, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

Mr. McFarlane then presented the Board two quotes for the purchase of a storage cabinet. Mr. McFarlane recommended that the Board acept the low quote of M & M Office Supply, Lawrence, for the purchase of a storage cabinet, #3487 All-Steel, tan, 36"x18"x78", in the amount of \$169. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.

Phil Leonard, emergency preparedness/risk management coordinator, appeared before the Board to discuss rates for health insurance. Mr. Leonard contacted Rates for 81-82 Kyle Ward, Blue Cross-Blue Shield representative, concerning the rates that will be charged for the contract year June 1, 1981 thru May 31, 1982 for the coverages listed below:
