

(4) Resolution No. 81-32 - Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that a speed limit of 30 miles per hour be determined and declared to be a reasonable and safe speed limit for the following described county road or highway:

Beginning at a point 1153.74 feet South and 254 feet West of the Northeast corner of the Northeast Quarter (N.E.¼) of Section 1, Township 14 South, Range 18 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Douglas County, Kansas, said point being at the intersection of F.A.S. Route 1371 and F.A.S. Route 206 in the Town of Lone Star and on Douglas County Route No. 1, thence Westerly on the center line of F.A.S. Route 1371 a distance of 1250 feet and terminating at said point.

(5) Resolution No. 81-33 - Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that a speed limit of 30 miles per hour be determined and declared to be a reasonable and safe speed limit for the following described county road or highway:

Beginning at a point 2018.74 feet North and 1987.64 feet East of the Southwest corner of the Northeast Quarter (N.E.¼) of Section 22, Township 13 South, Range 18 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Douglas County, Kansas, said point being the P.C. of a curve to the right with a radius of 287.94 feet and is on the center line of Douglas County Route No. 6, thence Northeasterly on said curve an arc distance of 165.0 feet to the P.T. of said curve, said point being on the center line of 2nd Street of Clinton, Kansas, thence East on the center line of said 2nd Street and Douglas County Route No. 6 a distance of approximately 990.0 feet to the intersection of "F" Street and 2nd Street, both of Clinton, Kansas, and terminating at said point.

(6) Resolution No. 81-34 - Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that a speed limit of 30 miles per hour be determined and declared to be a reasonable and safe speed limit for the following described county road or highway:

Beginning at the intersection of First Street and vacated "J" Street of Clinton, Kansas, said point being on the center line of Douglas County Route No. 4, thence East on the center line of said First Street and Douglas County No. 4, thence East on the center line of said First Street and Douglas County Route No. 4 a distance of approximately 937.5 feet to the East line of the Northeast Quarter (N.E.¼) of Section 22, Township 13 South, Range 18 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Douglas County, Kansas, and terminating at said point.

(7) Resolution No. 81-35 - Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that a speed limit of 30 miles per hour be determined and declared to be a reasonable and safe speed limit for the following described county road or highway:

Commencing at a point 30.0 feet South of the Northwest corner of the Northwest Quarter (N.W.¼) of Section 34, Township 14 South, Range 20 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Douglas County, Kansas, said point being on the West line of said Northwest Quarter (N.W.¼) and 10.0 feet West of the intersection of Douglas County Route No. 1055 and Douglas County Route No. 12, thence Easterly on the center line of said Douglas County Route No. 12 a distance of 5264.4 feet for a point of beginning, thence Easterly and Northerly on the center line of said Douglas County Route No. 12 to the Northerly boundary of Douglas County State Lake and terminating at said point.

(8) Resolution No. 81-36 - Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that a speed limit of 30 miles per hour be determined and declared to be a reasonable and safe speed limit for the following described county road or highway:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Southwest Quarter (S.W.¼) of Section 20, Township 12 South, Range 20 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Douglas County, Kansas, thence South on the West line of said Southwest Quarter (S.W.¼) for a distance of 0.5 mile to the Southwest corner of said Southwest Quarter (S.W.¼) (North City Limits of the City of Lawrence, Kansas) and terminating at said point, excluding all portions located within the City of Lawrence.

(9) Resolution No. 81-37 - Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that a speed limit of 40 miles per hour be determined and declared to be a reasonable and safe speed limit for the following described county road or highway:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter (N.E.¼) of Section 10, Township 13 South, Range 20 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Douglas County, Kansas, said point being on the center line of F.A.S. Route 2101 and Douglas County Route No. 442, thence East on the North line of said Northeast Quarter (N.E.¼) and on said center line a distance of 1500.0 feet and terminating at said point.

(10) Resolution No. 81-38 - Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that a speed limit of 40 miles per hour be determined and declared to be a reasonable and safe speed limit for the following described county road or highway:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the Northeast Quarter (N.E.¼) of Section 27, Township 12 South, Range 19 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Douglas County, Kansas, said point being on the center line of Kasold Street of the City of Lawrence, extended North, thence Southerly on said center line to a point 519.56 feet North of the Southeast corner of said Northeast Quarter (N.E.¼) and terminating at said point and excluding all portions in the City of Lawrence.
