(11) Resolution No. 81-39 - Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that a speed limit of 40 miles per hour be determined and declared to be a reasonable and safe speed limit for the following described county road or highway:

Beginning at the intersection of "F" Street and 2nd Street, both of Clinton, Kansas, said point being on the center line of Douglas County Route No. 6, thence East on the center line of said Douglas County Route No. 6 a distance of approximately 3135.0 feet and terminating at said point and excluding all portions located within the Clinton Lake Park Boundary.

(12) Resolution No. 81-40 - Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that a speed limit of 40 miles per hour be determined and declared to be a reasonable and safe speed limit for the following described county road or highway:

Beginning at a point 1664.06 feet North of the Southwest corner of the Northeast Quarter (N.E.¼) of Section 32, Township 13 South, Range 18 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Douglas County, Kansas, said point being the intersection of 3rd Street of Clinton, Kansas, and the West line of said Northeast Quarter (N.E.¼) and on Douglas County Route No. 6, thence East on the center line of said Douglas County Route No. 6 on an assumed bearing of N. 90°00'00" E. a distance of 1300.38 feet to the P.C. of a curve to the left with a radius of 478.34 feet, thence Northeasterly on said curve an arc distance of 275.28 feet to the P.T. of said curve, thence N. 56°58'00" E. a distance of 508.83 feet and terminating at said point.

(13) Resolution No. 81-41 - Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that a speed limit of 40 miles per hour be determined and declared to be a reasonable and safe speed limit for the following described county road or highway:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Southwest Quarter (S.W.¼) of Section 31, Township 13 South, Range 19 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Douglas County, Kansas, said point being on the center line of F.A.S. Route 206 and Douglas County Route No. 1, thence Southerly along said center line approximately 3859.2 feet to the intersection with F.A.S. Route 1371 (in the Town of Lone Star), said point being 1153.74 feet South and 254 feet West of the Northeast corner of the Northeast Quarter (N.E.¼) of Section 1, Township 14 South, Range 18 East.

(14) Resolution No. 81-42 - Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that a speed limit of 40 miles per hour be determined and declared to be a reasonable and safe speed limit for the following described county road or highway:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Northwest Quarter (N.W.¼) of Section 20, Township 12 South, Range 20 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Douglas County, Kansas, thence South on the West line of said Northwest Quarter (N.W.¼) a distance of 0.5 mile to the Southwest corner of said Northwest Quarter (N.W.¼) and terminating at said point.

(15) Resolution No. 81-43 - Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that a speed limit of 40 miles per hour be determined and declared to be a reasonable and safe speed limit for the following described county road or highway:

Beginning at the intersection of First Street of the Town of Clinton with the West line of the Northeast Quarter (N.E.¼) of Section 22, Township 13 South, Range 18 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Douglas County, Kansas, said point being 196 feet South of the Northwest corner of said Northeast Quarter (N.E.¼) and on the center line of Douglas County Route No. 4, thence East on First Street a distance of approximately 1686.5 feet to the intersection of said First Street and vacated "J" Street of Clinton, Kansas and terminating at said point.

(16) Resolution No. 81-44 - Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that a speed limit of 40 miles per hour be determined and declared to be a reasonable and safe speed limit for the following described county road or highway:

Beginning at a point on the North line of the Northwest Quarter (N.W.¼) of Section 31, Township 12 South, Range 19 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Douglas County, Kansas, said point being 660 feet East of the Northwest corner of said Northwest Quarter (N.W.¼) and on the center line of F.A.S. Route 212 and Douglas County Route No. 442, thence East on said center line to a point 660 feet East of the Northeast corner of said Northwest Quarter (N.W.¼) and terminating at said point.

(17) Resolution No. 81-45 - Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that a speed limit of 40 miles per hour be determined and declared to be a reasonable and safe speed limit for the following described county road or highway:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 24, Township 12 South, Range 19 East, in Douglas County, Kansas, said point being on the centerline of Iowa Street; thence North on said center line a distance of 5044.22 feet, more or less, thence on a curve to the left with a radius of 250 feet a distance of 392.70 feet, more or less, to a point on the center line of County Road No. 31-C (Lakeview Road), said point being 250 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 14, Township 12 South, Range 19 East, and on the South line of said Section 14 and terminating at said point excluding all portions located within the City of Lawrence.
