The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with two members of the Board present. Mrs. Bradley was absent.

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Approved the minutes of the meeting of October 21, 1981.

Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board and presented the Board a contract for right-of-way for Project No. 81-3, Bridge No. 11.08N-18.83E, between the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County and Tom O. Akin Enterprises, Inc., Lawrence, for 2.4607 acres of right-of-way easement and 143 rods of barbed fence, in the lump sum of \$2108.87. This lump sum payment includes allowance for ten corner posts and braces. After review of this contract it was moved by Mr. Cragan that it be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried.

Mr. Dooley then recommended the acceptance of a Supplemental Agreement, Change Order No. 1, for Douglas County Bridge and Grading Contract for Consolidated Project No. 80-1 as follows:

Bridge No. 02.00N-12.00E

Net decrease of \$59.06 for a final contract price for this bridge in the amount of \$98,199.69.

Bridge No. 02.01N-11.00E

Net increase of \$89.75 for a final contract price for this bridge in the amount of \$110,281.25.

Bridge No. 06.00N-00.49E

Net decrease of \$94.31 for a final contract price for this bridge in the amount of \$100,957.44.

The total contract price is decreased \$63.62 by this change order making the total final contract price of \$309,438.38. It is noted by the Board that these recommendations are concurred in by the contractor, Finney & Turnipseed, by the bonding company, and Mr. Dooley. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this change order be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on Monday, October 26, 1981.

Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board and presented Specifications and Contract Documents for Douglas County Consolidated Project No. 81-3 which includes bridge and grading contract for Bridge No. 11.08N-18.83E and Bridge No. 19.89N-15.00E. Mr. Dooley recommends that this Notice to Contractors be published on October 29, November 5 and November 12, 1981, in the newspaper of record of Douglas County and recommends that bids be received at the office of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County until 10:30 a.m., C.S.T., on November 19, 1981, at which time the bids will be publicly opened. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that the recommended dates for publication and bid opening be accepted, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.
