Heck, husband and wife, Recorded Owners, and Perry Kitsmiller, Ralph Kitsmiller, and Roger Kitsmiller, Contract Buyers, for 0.415 acres of right-of-way easement and 0.073 acres of temporary easement for construction, in the lump sum of \$509.08.
