After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that it be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Dooley then presented the Board an Application from the Kansas Public Service Company, seeking authority to construct a natural gas pipeline under Clinton Parkway in the vicinity of Crossgates Drive. This application has been discussed with the City Engineer and City Public Works Director and approval is recommended by Mr. Dooley with the following stipulations:

(1) The crossing be completely encased within the right-of-way with vents installed at the right-of-way lines.

(2) Trenching would be allowed on both sides between the sidewalk and the frontage road only.

(3) Kansas Public Service would be responsible for backfill for up to one year.

(4) All disturbed areas would be seeded, fertilized, and mulched with mixed designation by the City Park and Recreation Department.

After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this Application be approved subject to the recommendations of Mr. Dooley, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.
