The total estimated cost for this project is \$2600. Douglas County states that sufficient funds are now, or will be, available and are hereby pledged to the Secretary in the amount and at the time required for the Supplementing of Federal funds available for the comletion of this project. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this Request for Construction Project be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously. Reg. of Deerls: Purch Typewriter Sue Neustifter, register of deeds, appeared before the Board with a quote
