Rev Shan! 3-1982 allocations Ernest Coleman, federal funds consultant, appeared before the Board to recommend the acceptance of three revenue sharing contracts from the 1982 allocation as follows:

After complete review it was moved by Mr. Cragan that these contracts be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried.

Boning's 4th Quarte report Wayne Kellum, zoning administrator, appeared before the Board to present the Fourth Quarter Report for 1981 of the transactions which have taken place in his department. Mr. Kellum indicated the issuance of twenty building permits for new homes or additions to residences with a total declared value to be \$593,000. Permits were issued for two mobile homes with a total declared value of \$16,500 and one commercial for a total declared value of \$11,000. The total estimated value for the three months period is \$620,500 and the total fees collected by his department is \$378. This figure compares to a Fourth Quarter Report of 1980 of a total estimated value of \$592,900. Mr. Kellum also presented a Summary Report for 1981. These reports are on file in the commission office.

Rea 83-5: Been license Way-Co. The Board considered Resolution No. 82-5 which resolution relates to granting a cereal malt beverage license to Charles R. Waymire for use at Way-Co, Inc., Route 2, Baldwin, Kansas. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this resolution be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried.
