## April 12, 1982

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present.

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Approved the minutes of the meeting of April 8 and 9, 1982.

Appraiser Don Gordon notified the Board that Russell Bartley and Genevieve Versonnel' Term Hildebrand have completed the revaluation of farm machinery and equipment for 1982 and should be removed from the payroll effective April 9, 1982.

> The Board considered Resolution No. 82-9 which resolution refers specifically to the requirements of K.S.A. 19-436 which statute requires that the Board give public notice of the total projected budget of the county appraiser's office for fiscal year 1983 in order that that amount levied for that purpose shall be exempt from the aggregate tax levy limitations of Douglas County, and if within sixty days after the last publication of this notice a petition signed by electors of Douglas County equal in number to not less than five percent of the total qualified electors of Douglas County is filed in the office of the County Election Officer requesting an election thereon, such costs shall be within the aggregate tax levy limitation of the county unless a proposition to exclude the same from such limitation is submitted to and approved by a majority of the electors of the county voting at an election called and held thereon. If within such period no sufficient protest is filed or if the electors approve such proposition at an election called and held thereon, that portion of the tax levies of such county which is levied for the purpose of paying costs incurred by the county in complying with the provisions of K.S.A. 19-430 et seq. shall not be included in computing the aggregate tax levies of the county and as exempt from the limitations imposed under the provision of K.S.A. 75-5001 to 79-5016, inclusive. After complete review of the details of this resolution it was moved by Mr. Neis that the projected budget for 1982 for the county appraiser's office be set for the purpose of publication to be \$268,950, and that the details of this resolution be published in accordance with K.S.A. 19-436 in order that this projected budgeted amount may be exempt from the aggregate tax levy of Douglas County for the budget year 1983. This motion was seconded by Mr. Cragan and carried unanimously.

The Board approved monthly fee reports for the following county offices: County Clerk, Sheriff, Public Works, and Register of Deeds.

The Board met with Sandra Shaw and Annette Kahn (Bert Nash), Scott Courtney (District Court Services), and Ernest Coleman (federal funds consultant) to discuss the second year GCCA grant application entitled "Douglas County Family Focus Program", Subgrant No. JF-80-20-1421, in the total amount of \$132,410.28. A breakdown is as follows:

After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this grant application be approved for the second year with the understanding that in this year, and in future years, funds are not intended to be drawn from Douglas County levy funds or revenue sharing funds but that Douglas County's role in this grant application is purely as sponsor and fiscal agent, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

No further business, the Board adjourned to=meet on Wednesday, April 14, 1982.



April 14, 1982

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present.

Approved the minutes of the meeting of April 12, 1982.

The Board discussed a policy for copy machine charges for bulk copies for all of the copy machines owned or leased by Douglas County. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that any individual requesting 100 or more copies at one time shall be charged the rate of 10¢ per copy, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

At the hour of 10:00 a.m., the Board discussed three planning items with Garner Stoll, Director of the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Department; David Guntert, staff member of the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Department; and Wayne Kellum, County Zoning Administrator. The Board first considered Item No. 14 from the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Commission minutes of March 24, 1982. This item is a Text Amendment--Amending Article 9A, Section 9A-2 in the "B-3" Limited Business District Regulations of the Zoning Regulations for Unincorporated Territory of Douglas County, Kansas, by adding motels and motor hotels and overnight camping trailer grounds to permitted uses. This item comes to the Board with a recommendation of approval from the Planning Commission. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that the Board concur in the recommendation of the Planning Commission seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

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
