las County Planning Commission minutes of March 24, 1982. This item is a request to rezone from B-2 (General Business) to B-1 (Neighborhood Business) approximately 8.25 acres. It is generally described as being located south of the Clinton Lake Water Treatment Plant on the NW corner of Dragstrip Road and Clinton Parkway and initiated by the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Commission. This item comes to the Board with a recommendation of approval

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This resolution amends Article 9A, Section 9A-2 in the "B-3" Limited Busines District Regulations of the Zoning Regulations for Unincorporated Territory of Douglas County, Kansas, by adding motels and motor hotels and overnight camping trailer grounds to permitted uses. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this resolution be approved and published in accordance with the requirements of the law, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board and presented Contract 23 C-1401-01 a Contract for Federal Aid Road Construction by County for Project No. 23 C-1401-01 (PMS-1 [40]), whereas the Secretary of Transportation of the State No porosing bigns of Kansas, as Agent for Douglas County, Kansas, authorizes said County to perform certain construction work on the above noted Project No. consisting of installation of "No Passing" signs at various locations in Douglas County. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this contract be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously. It should be noted that this is a 100% federally funded project.

> Mr. Dooley then presented the Board three quotes for the purchase of 850 Route Markers and 570 Arrow Signs on aluminum blanks. Mr. Dooley recommended that the Board accept the low quote of National Sign Company, Inc., Ottawa, Kansas, in the amount of \$12,319.90. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Dooley then presented the Board three quotes for the purchase of 383 aluminum and 383 steel blank signs. Mr. Dooley recommended that the Board accept the low quote of Newman Sign Company, Jamestown, North Dakota, for the purchase of 383 aluminum blank signs, in the amount of \$6549.30. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously. These signs will be 100% federally funded.
