## October 13, 1982

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present. Student representatives Parris Riordan and Amy Lucas were also present for the meeting.

Approved the minutes of the meeting of October 11, 1982.

The Board approved Commissioners Cancellation Order No. 3076. Order is on file in the office of the County Clerk.

At the hour of 10:00 a.m., as advertised, the Board opened bids to supply and install a telecommunications system at the new building to be occupied by the Douglas County Ambulance Service at 225 Maine Street, Lawrence, Kansas. Four bids were received. After a brief review it was moved by Mr. Neis that we take the bids under advisement for review by Mr. McFarlane and to make a recommendation at a later time, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

The Board considered a Site Plan Review, SP-9-45-82, which is a request for an antique store located approximately 6 miles west of Lawrence on Highway 40 at Kanwaka corner, submitted by Mike Gasper. This site plan was presented to the Board by David Guntert, staff member of the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Department. Also present was Price Banks, Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Department Director; Linda Finger, staff member; Wayne Kellum, zoning administrator; and Dan Young, county counselor. The planning staff recommended approval of the above referenced site plan subject to the following condition:

(1) A building permit be obtained from the Zoning Administrator's Office.

After a complete review it was moved by Mr. Neis that the Board approve the site plan, subject to the above-described condition, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board and presented a Contract for Temporary Easement for Project No. 80-1 Twin Mound, between the Temp. Ease Temp. Ease Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County and Georgetta Goodyear and I James E. Goodyear, her husband, for 0.16 acres of temporary easement for Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County and Georgetta Goodyear and construction and 16 rods of woven fence, in the lump sum of \$252. After review of this contract it was moved by Mr. Cragan that it be approved, seconded

by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Dooley then presented the Board an Application to the Division of Water Resources of the State Board of Agriculture to construct 77'-94'-80'-53' continuous steel beam spans with 36'-00" roadway across the Wakarusa River on the Section line between the Northeast Quarter (N.E.1) of Section 19, and the Beams. 20-13-20 Northwest Quarter (N.W.1) of Section 20, Township 13 South, Range 20 East, in Douglas County, Kansas, for the purpose of permitting passage of vehicular traffic. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this Application be approved and then forwarded to the State Board of Agriculture, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

> The Board approved monthly fee reports for the following county offices: County Clerk, Sheriff, Public Works, and Register of Deeds.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on Thursday, October 14, 1982.
