## October 20, 1982 The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present. Approved the minutes of the meeting of October 18, 1982. The Board approved Commissioners Cancellation Order No. 3077, 3078, 3079, and 3080. Orders are on file in the office of the County Clerk. At the hour of 9:00 a.m., as advertised, Mike Dooley, public works director, Vacate: appeared before the Board in regard to a Request to Vacate Roads. This request is to vacate part of Road No. 516, part of Road No. 34, and Road No. 516-34-1318 318. Mr. Dooley stated that he had not received concurrence from the Eudora parts . Township Board. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that the Board defer action until we have received concurrence from the Eudora Township Board, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously. Mr. Dooley then presented the Board three quotes for the purchase of regular Pub. Works: gasoline, diesel fuel, and unleaded gasoline. Mr. Dooley recommended that Purch fuel the Board accept the low quote from Zaroco, Inc., Lawrence, for the purchase of the following: approximately 2000 gallons of regular gasoline at the total price of \$1.043 per gallon, approximately 4000 gallons of diesel fuel at the total price of \$0.989 per gallon, and approximately 2500 gallons of unleaded gasoline at the total price of \$1.077 per gallon. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that these recommendations be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously. Pub. Works: Mr. Dooley then presented the Board a quote from Sellers Tractor Company, Inc., Topeka, Kansas, for parts for a crane, 405C, S/N 12535, in the total Purch ports amount of \$1280.15. Mr. Dooley recommended that this quote be approved. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously. The Board noted receipt of a statement dated August 23, 1982, from Garr & Imbulance. Bell, attorneys, Overland Park, Kansas, for legal services rendered in con-Stalement Darr nection with the authorization and issuance of Douglas County temporary notes in the principal amount of \$100,000. The statement is in the amount of H Bell on bonds \$402.94. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this statement be approved and paid from Revenue Sharing-Ambulance Building Fund, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously. Personnel: Employ Ruth Foster, Valleyview administrator, appeared before the Board to recommend employment of the following: W. Rile (1) Debbie A. Riley, in the position of certified nurse aide, permanent, P. Wall full-time, at the rate of \$3.55 per hour, effective October 11, 1982. (2) Patra C. Wade, in the position of certified nurse aide, temporary, part-time, at the rate of \$3.55 per hour, effective October 17, 1982.

After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that these recommendations be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Mrs. Foster then notified the Board of the following terminations: Alice Steerwold on September 27, and Desmond Chikezie on October 13, 1982.

D. Chikezie A. O.A 7. Dean Mrs. Foster then notified the Board that Frances Dean began a leave-ofabsence effective October 18, 1982, for seventy-five working days.

Riclass Mrs. Foster then recommended the following changes, effective October 9, 1982:
