George Little, data processing director, appeared before the Board with a quote from IBM, Topeka, for the purchase of a Model No. 3278 terminal in the amount of \$2057. Mr. Little recommended that this quote be approved. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Little then presented the Board a quote from IBM, Topeka, for the purchase of two IBM, No. 3370, disc drives, in the total amount of \$53,365.80. Mr. Little recommended that \$40,000 of this amount be paid from the 1982 budget. This will leave monthly payments of \$1909.40 with the final payment to be made in August 1983.
