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Mike Dooley, public works director, notified the Board that Elmer F. Jolliff will terminate on April 29, 1983.

Mr. Dooley then recommended that the Board accept the quote from Harbour Bros. Construction Company, Kansas City, Kansas, for asphalt sealing throughout Douglas County, in the total amount of \$141,106.78. Blacktop Construction Company, Emporia, Kansas, submitted the low quote but Mr. Dooley recommended Harbour Bros. Construction Company, who submitted next to the low quote, for the following reasons:

- (1) Quotes from the two firms were unbalanced and usually we overrun rock. The quote from Harbour Bros. Construction Company had a lower unit price for spreading the rock.
- (2) Harbour Bros. Construction Company will use a larger distributor which should decrease time.
- (3) There was some dissatisfaction with the operation of Blacktop Construction Company from last year's sealing program.
