Versonnel Reclass Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board and discussed a disciplinary action for Howard Miskimen. As a result of three accidents in the past thirty days, it is the recommendation of the review committee. that Mr. Miskimen who is presently classified as a semi-skilled equipment operator at a salary of \$12,761.32 per year, be reclassified to a common laborer at a salary of \$10,761.40 per year, effective June 18, 1983. It is also recommended that Mr. Miskimen be placed on probation for a period of three months with a review for possible extension at that time. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that these recommendations be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously. Mr. Dooley then presented the Board with two quotes for the purchase of ten Pub Works 10.00-20, 14 ply, Michelin radial XZY truck tires. Mr. Dooley recommended Purch Tires that the Board accept the low quote from D & D Tire Company, Lawrence, in the amount of \$2500. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously. Mr. Dooley then presented the Board a contract for right-of-way for Project Pul. Works No. 23 C-1817-01, Road No. 160, between the Board of County Commissioners of R/W Robertson Douglas County and the Estate of Jeff A. Robertson, deceased; Ruth Agnes Robertson, Co-Executor; and Myron E. Yadon, Co-Executor, for 107 rods of Rd. 160 barb fence and 29 rods of temporary fencing, in the lump sum of \$1400. After review of this contract it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that it be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert and carried unanimously. Mr. Dooley then presented the Board an Easement for Right-of-Way for Highway R/W Easement Purposes from the Estate of Jeff A. Robertson, deceased, for Douglas County "obertain Project No. 23 C-1817-01, Road No. 160, Bridge No. 4.50N-2.29, for the following described lands, situated in Douglas County and State of Kansas, Rol. 160 to-wit: The part of the Northwest Quarter $(N.W.\frac{1}{4})$ of Section 30, Township 14 South, Range 18 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Douglas County, Kansas, described as follows: Commencing at the Southwest Corner of said Northwest Quarter $(N.W.\frac{1}{4})$, thence East on the South line of said Northwest Quarter (N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$) on an assumed bearing of N. 90°00'00" E. a distance of 345.90 feet, to the point of beginning of the land to be described, thence N. 0°00'00" E. a distance of 25.00 feet, thence N. 84°28'21" É. a distance of 155.72 feet, thence N. 90°00'00" E. a distance of 585.00 feet, thence N. 85° 31'58" E. a distance of 320.98 feet, thence N. 90°00'00" E. a distance of 195.00 feet, thence S. 87°08'15" E. a distance of 400.50 feet, thence S. 78°41'24" E. a distance of 101.98 feet, thence S. 0°00'00" E. a distance of 25.00 feet to a point on the South line of said Northwest Quarter (N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$), thence S. 90°00'00" W. on the South line of said Northwest Quarter (N.W.1) a distance of 1755.00 feet to the point of beginning, less existing highway. 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Bob Soph, representative of the Lockwood Company, Inc., Atchison, and Sue Nestifter, register of deeds, appeared before the Board to discuss plat cabi-

nets. Mr. Soph recommended that the register of deeds office purchase two plat cabinets, one cabinet that will hold 200 envelopes and one cabinet that will hold 100 envelopes, in the amount not to exceed \$6250. This will also include hangers and installation. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously.

The Board approved monthly fee reports for the following county offices: County Clerk, Public Works, Register of Deeds, and Sheriff.

Fremont Hornberger, maintenance supervisor, appeared before the Board and presented a Cooperative Work Site Agreement (Community Works Experience Program) between Douglas County and the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services (SRS). SRS is desirous of entering into this (contractual relationship) to establish CWEP work site/sites to give work experience to ablebodies person receiving public assistance from the State Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this Agreement be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously.

At the hour of 10:00 a.m., the Board discussed three planning items with David Guntert, staff member of the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Department and Wayne Kellum, zoning administrator. Attorney John Lungstrum and John Selk, engineer, were also present. The Board considered Item No. 8 from the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Commission minutes of May 25, 1983. This item is a request to rezone from A (Agricultural) to A-1 (Suburban Home Residential) approximately 70.21 acres. The property is generally located eight miles southeast of Lawrence and one mile west of County Road 1055 on Palmyra Township Road No. 455, requested by Mike Flory for Wayne Flory,
