The Secretary of Transportation proposes to repair a portion of State Highway Route US-59 under a project designated by number 59-23 K-2461-01, Douglas County, Kansas, and the work includes a repair of slide area on land owned by Mr. Long, Mr. Owens, and Douglas County. The parties hereto agree that the cost of the slide repair shall be divided as follows: Mr. Long will pay \$1500; Douglas County will pay \$3505; and the Secretary of Transportation will pay the remainder of the cost of the project. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this Agreement be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously.
