C. Grodidies Plon Comm. The Board considered the appointment of Cletus Grosdidier, Route 1, Eudora, Kansas, as a member of the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Commission, for a three-year term which will expire on May 31, 1986. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this appointment be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously.

Grant Section 8 Housing assl. David Murrell from the Lawrence Housing Authority appeared before the Board and presented an annual contributions contract between the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and Douglas County for the Section 8 Housing Assistance Payments Program (30 units of existing housing). After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Hiebert that the contract be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.
