The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present.

Approved the minutes of the meeting of September 15, 1983.

The Board approved Commissioners Cancellation Order No. 3171. Order is on Comm. Order # 3/71 file in the office of the County Clerk.

Mike Dooley notified the Board that because of excessive absenteeism, subconnel Term standard work performance, consistent misuse and neglect of equipment, that Bill Taylor will be terminated today.

At 9:28 a.m. it was moved by Mrs. Bradley and seconded by Mrs. Hiebert that the Board adjourn to go into executive session to discuss personnel matters Elec. Session. Disc. Dooley with Mike Dooley, public works director, Motion carried. The Board resumed regular session at 9:35 a.m.

Mr. Dooley then presented the Board an Application from Southwestern Bell Telephone Company requesting authority to construct buried telephone cable in Section 12, Township 13 South, Range 20 East.
