The Board discussed a Site Plan Review (SP-11-67-83) with David Guntert, Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Department staff member. Wayne Kellum, zoning administrator, was also present. This site plan is for Lawrence Auto Salvage (formerly Rees' Auto Salvage) located approximately one mile east of Lawrence on the south side of Highway 10, submitted by Michael Treanor Architects for Laird Noller.

Staff Review: A Conditional Use Permit was approved by the Board of County Commissioners on July 15, 1980, to establish a salvage yard on this property. Since the use has already been established, staff has concluded that only site plan approval be obtained for the new building. It should also be noted that the conditions imposed upon the original owner still apply to the property and new owner.

A review of the site plan has found it to be in substantial conformance with the original conditions of CUP approval and the site plan requirements, but the following information should be added for clarification:

(1) The screening/security fence should be continued across the entire length of the north side.

The planning staff recommends approval of the site plan subject to the following conditions:

(1) The information noted in the staff review be added to the site plan; and,

(2) The applicant obtain approval of a septic system from the Health Department prior to issuance of a building permit for the new garage.

After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Hiebert that the Board concur in the recommendations of the planning staff subject to the above described conditions and also that an advertising sign no larger than 10'x10' be erected, and the existing screening fence on the south and west side be repaired, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried.
