Treasurer: Mrs. Vervynck then recommended the purchase of two Sharp calculators from Logan Business Machine, Topeka, in the total amount of \$448, to be paid from the Treasurer's 1983 budget. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Hiebert that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.

Sheriff: Sheriff Rex Johnson presented the Board a quote from Inland Business Systems of Kansas, Inc., Topeka, and recommended the purchase of an IBM Selectric III Model 6705 electric typewriter, in the amount of \$823. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously.

Fairgrounds: Fremont Hornberger, maintenance supervisor, appeared before the Board to discuss the purchase of furnaces for Building 1 and 2 at the Douglas County 4-H Fairgrounds. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that the purchase of furnaces for Building 1 and 2 be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously.

Valleyview: Mr. Hornberger then presented the Board a statement in the amount of \$1724 from Johnson Controls, Kansas City, Kansas, as the final payment of the energy management system installed at Valleyview Care Home. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Hiebert that this statement be approved and paid from revenue sharing funds, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.

After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously.

Pub. Works: Mr. Dooley then presented the Board a quote from M & M Office Supply, Lawrence, and recommended purchase of the following:
