Fremont Hornberger, maintenance supervisor, appeared before the Board to recommend that the Board accept a telephone quote from Emporia Wholesaler, Emporia, Kansas, for the purchase of a Model RT Bunn, 5-burner coffeemaker, in the amount of \$599.95. This coffeemaker is to be used in the kitchen where the food is prepared for the prisoners in the Judicial and Law Enforcement Center. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Hiebert that this recommendation be approved and paid from the maintenance department budget, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.

Wayne Kellum, zoning administrator, appeared before the Board to present the Fourth Quarter Report for 1983 of the transactions which have taken place in his department. Mr. Kellum indicated the issuance of fourteen building permits for new homes or additions to residences with a total declared value to be \$471,000. Permits were issued for two mobile homes with a declared value to be \$10,000 and two commercial for a total declared value of \$42,500. The total estimated value for the three months period is \$523,500 and the total fees collected by his department is \$506. This figure compares to a Fourth Quarter Report of 1982 of a total estimated value of \$475,600. Mr. Kellum also presented a Summary Report for 1983.
