The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present.

The Board approved Commissioners Cancellation Order No. 3227 and 3228. Orders are on file in the office of the County Clerk.

The Board opened two quotes for the purchase of regular gasoline, unleaded gasoline, and diesel fuel. Mr. Dooley recommended that the Board accept the low quote from Zaroco Inc., Lawrence, for the following: 1300 gallons of regular gasoline at \$0.8828, 4650 gallons of unleaded gasoline at \$0.9128 per gallon, and 2450 gallons of diesel fuel at \$0.8367 per gallon. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Hiebert that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

The Board considered Resolution No. 84-5 which resolution rescinds Resolution No. 84-2. By this resolution the Board of County Commissioners, pursuant to K.S.A. 1983 Supp., 17-5002, and K.S.A. 1983 Supp., 12-1675, is given authority to invest its funds not immediately required for the purposes for which the funds were collected or received; and K.S.A. 1983 Supp. 19-1401 requires this governing body to designate official depositories for such investments. Pursuant to the above cited statutes, the Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes the investment of funds not immediately required for the purposes for which the funds were collected or received in savings deposits of the following commercial banks and savings associations having their respective home offices in Douglas County: Lawrence Federal Savings, Kaw Valley Bank, Douglas County Bank, First National Bank of Lawrence, Lawrence National Bank, University State Bank, and Baldwin State Bank.
