Mr. Dooley then presented the Board an Agreement between the City of Lawrence, Kansas, and Douglas County for project called 31st Street from Iowa West to Kasold Drive. The County does hereby request the City to take such steps as are necessary for the purpose of securing approval of the Federal Highway Administration of a project for the improvement of a road or street, which project is locally known as 31st Street and is described as follows: A fourlane roadway of approximately one mile in length which will begin at the intersection of Highway 59 or Iowa Street in Lawrence, thence West one mile through the City of Lawrence and Douglas County to connect with Kasold Drive. It is agreed that all construction items included in the approved plans shall be paid for with a combination of Federal and local funds. It is understood that the Federal share is seventy-five percent of the total project expense, and the local share is twenty-five percent. Of the twenty-five percent local share, it is mutually agreed that the County shall bear forty percent and the City shall bear sixty percent except as otherwise stated in Items 2 and 3 of the Agreement. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Hiebert that this Agreement be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.
