This item is a Final Plat of Pleasant Meadow Estates, a two lot county subdivision located on the east side of Wakarusa Township Road #216, approximately two miles south of Lawrence and one mile west of U. S. Highway 59. The plat contains approximately 8.36 acres, submitted by Landplan Engineering for Johnny B. and Nancy Ezell. This item comes to the Board with a recommendation of approval from the planning commission for the acceptance of dedications and easements, subject to the following condition:

- (1) The applicant's engineer certify the lots have been pinned or a bond in an amount sufficient to cover the cost of pinning be submitted.
