Mrs. Bradley was absent due to attending a noxious weed conference in Topeka. Approved the minutes of the meeting of March 5, 1984. The Board approved Commissioners Cancellation Order No. 3244. Order is on Comm. Order; file in the office of the County Clerk. 3244 Ruth Foster, Valleyview administrator, recommended the employment of Beatrice I. Brooks, in the position of certified nurse aide, permanent, part-time, at Personnel: Employ the rate of \$3.55 per hour, effective February 25, 1984. After discussion it B. Brooks was moved by Mr. Neis that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried. Mrs. Foster then recommended the following changes, effective February 25, fectors 1984: N. Mooney. (1) Debbie Mooney a probationary raise, from \$3.79 per hour to \$3.89 D. Warren per hour. (2) Dianna Warren a probationary raise, from \$3.79 per hour to \$3.89 per hour. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that these recommendations be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried. The Board approved monthly fee reports for the following county offices: County Clerk, Sheriff, Public Works, and Register of Deeds. Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board with a contract Pul Works ! for right-of-way for Project No. Br. 10.44N-12.00E, Road No. 216 (Rd. I.D. No. R/W Salst 1200E), between the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County and Edgar Salsbury and Dorothy E. Salsbury, his wife, recorded owners, and Arden Booth, contract buyer, for 0.115 acres of right-of-way easement, 0.103 acres of temporary easement for construction, and 37 rods of woven fence, in the lump sum of \$706. This lump sum payment includes allowance for 12 rods of temporary fencing. After review of this contract it was moved by Mr. Neis that it be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried. Works: requested to program for construction that portion of FAS Route No. 209 lo-KDUT-FAS 209 cated North of Eudora, Kansas, which includes steel plate guard fence, for an estimated total for project to be \$17,000. Surveys and plans will be made by Finney & Turnipseed Transporation and Civil Engineering and suffi-

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cient funds of Douglas County are now, or will be, available and hereby pledged to KDOT in the amount and at the time required for the Supplementing of Federal funds available for the completion of this project. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this Request for Construction Project be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried.

Mr. Dooley then recommended the approval of an Agreement between Douglas Pub. Works: Agree Schwab-Enter 18.55N-11.50 E County, Kansas, and Schwab-Eaton, consulting engineers and land surveyors, Manhattan, Kansas. This Agreement is relative to normal field survey, utility locations, balanced grading plans, culvert designs, construction cost estimate, contour maps, bridge layouts, detailed bridge plans, and necessary approvals for Bridge No. 18.58N-11.50E, located approximately 2.6 miles north and 1.5 miles west of the intersection of US 40 and K-10 in Lawrence, in the amount of \$6150. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried.
