The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present.

Approved the minutes of the meeting of March 14, 1984.

Pub. Works: Acceptlowbid 83-8 Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board to recommend that the Board accept the low bid from Taylor Construction Co., Lenexa, in the amount of \$6,345.60 from Douglas County Bridge Project No. 83-8, repair of Eudora Bridge over the Kansas river. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that the low bid from Project No. 83-8 be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously.

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At 9:10 a.m. the Board accompanied Fremont Hornberger, maintenance supervisor, out to the Douglas County 4-H fairgrounds to inspect buildings #1 and 2. The Board returned at 9:45 a.m.

Mr. Hornberger then presented the Board three quotes to install heating and ductwork for two 250,000 BTU heaters and two 7½ ton air conditioners to be installed in buildings #1 and 2 at the Douglas County 4-H fairgrounds. Mr. Hornberger recommended that the Board accept the low quote from Rhodes Heating & Roofing, Lawrence, in the amount of \$12,975. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Hiebert that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Hornberger then presented the Board two quotes to install new wiring and light fixtures in the firing range, now being used as a storage room in the Judicial Building basement. Mr. Hornberger recommended that the Board accept the low quote from Alliance Electric, Inc., Lawrence, in the amount of \$812.85. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously.
