Wayne Kellum, zoning administrator, appeared before the Board to present the First Quarter Report for 1984 of the transactions which have taken place in his department. Mr. Kellum indicated the issuance of sixteen building permits for new homes or additions to residences with a total declared value to be \$735,200. Permits were issued for two mobile homes with a declared value to be \$18,000. The total estimated value for the three months period is \$753,200 and the total fees collected by his department is \$424.30. This figure compares to a First Quarter Report of 1983 of a total estimated value of \$953,000. This report is on file in the commission office.

At the hour of 10:00 a.m., the Board discussed a planning item with David Guntert, Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Department staff member. Wayne Kellum, zoning administrator, and Mike Dooley, public works director, were also present. The Board considered Item No. 7 from the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Commission minutes of November 16, 1983. This item is a final plat of SEAS Subdivision, a 16 lot subdivision containing approximately 54.87 acres. The property is located north of Clinton Reservoir (approximately 2.5 miles west of Lawrence) on the east side of Kanwaka Township Road #65, submitted by Evans, Bierly, Hutchison and Associates for Property Development Company, Inc. Mr. Guntert stated that several changes have been made on the final plat since the planning commission approved the plat. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Hiebert that the Board send this plat back to the planning commission for their approval, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.
