Sheriff Rex Johnson notified the Board that Shaun Price terminated on March 19, 1984.

Mr. Johnson then recommended that the Board approve the employment of Timothy D. Blosser, in the position of corrections officer, at a salary of \$13,200 per year, effective April 16, 1984. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Johnson then recommended that the Board accept the low quote from Turner Chevrolet, Lawrence, for the purchase of a new 1984 Chevrolet Blazer, with trade-in, in the amount of \$5590.52. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously.

Ruth Vervynck, treasurer, presented the Board four quotes for the purchase of 150,000 Douglas County tax bills, continuous form. Mrs. Vervynck recommended that the Board accept the low quote from Bank and Commercial Printers, Kansas City, Kansas, in the amount of \$63.40 per thousand. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Hiebert that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

The Board considered the appointment of Gaye Groene, Route 6, Lawrence, as a member of the Lawrence-Douglas County Public Health Board, for a three-year term which will expire on March 31, 1987. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Hiebert that this appointment be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously. Mrs. Groene is replacing Gary Roberts.

District Attorney Jerry Harper requested the Board to adopt a Proclamation declaring the week of April 15-21, 1984, to be "Victim Rights Week" and urge all citizens and institutions to participate in programs and activities to assure these important rights. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Hiebert that this request be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

The Board approved monthly fee reports for the following county offices: County Clerk, Sheriff, Public Works, and Register of Deeds.

The Board discussed the Agreement between Douglas County and the City of Lawrence in regard to the 1956 Wing renovation of the Lawrence Memorial Hospital. The Lawrence City Commission has determined that the 1956 Wing shall be renovated for use by the Lawrence-Douglas County Health Department, the Bert Nash Mental Health Center, and the Visiting Nurses Association, and has allocated \$115,500 of Revenue Sharing and Community Development funds for said renovation. The Lawrence City Commission and the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County share in the funding of the Lawrence-Douglas County Health Department and the Bert Nash Mental Health Clinic. The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County will participate with the City of Lawrence in paying for the renovation of the 1956 Wing by providing \$237,500 after a review of final plans and any construction bid recommendations are made. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Hiebert that the Board approve this Agreement with the changes made by the county and send the Agreement to the City of Lawrence and the Lawrence City Commission for their approval, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.
